Finding Pre-Trial Litigation Forms for New York

- A. General tips for finding forms for your jurisdiction / topic
 - 1. best if you already know the name of form *e.g.* Summons & Complaint, Demand for Bill of Particulars, Notice For Deposition, Notice of Discovery and Inspection, Subpoena
 - may want to use only part of name e.g. "bill of particulars"
 - 2. your favorite reference librarian
 - 3. research guides for litigation / forms for your jurisdiction go to a Law School Library web
 - site for that state see handout at http://libguides.law.hofstra.edu/newyork_forms
 - 4. know some good overall NY sets (in print or online) see research guides from tip 3.
 - 5. for forms, sometimes print REALLY IS EASIER !!!
 - find the form in print then download from Bloomberg, Lexis or Westlaw

B. Online strategies

- 1. Google Summons and Complaint New York form
- 2. WestlawNext
- search *complaint* use post search filters to narrow to forms and NY
- WL Next Forms > NY > Litigation: Civil Trial
- in template try exact phrase (use quotations for phrase)
- search exact phrase "summons and complaint"
 - use filters to limit
- Search specific title and look through Table of Contents McKinney's Forms > TOC > CPLR > Ch.4 Pleadings > Complaint > 4.3 General Form
- search title "demand for bill of particulars"
- search Preliminary "bill of particulars" > use TOC
- in search bar search "New York Pattern" need to spell out ny Contracts>Generally Damages>breach of employment use for jury instructions <u>and</u> research

3. Lexis Advance

- search "notice for deposition" post search filters Forms and NY
- search notice /s deposition post search filters Forms, NY and Notice
- pre-search filter Filters>Category > Forms
 - o search *subpoena* then post search filter NY and Form Type> Subpoena
- search "notice of discovery and inspection" post search filters NY and Form Type see Source chapter TOC click on "Forms" in heading
- 4 Bloomberg Law Docket search will pull up actual filed documents
 - Litigation and Dockets>Search Dockets> *complaint* (limit to Nassau County)
