### NEW “IDEAS” SECTION RECEIVES MUCH ATTENTION

By now you may have heard that *Hofstra Law Review* has revolutionized legal scholarship with the introduction of a new section: “Ideas.” First appearing in Volume 33, No. 4, “Ideas” features short essays (three to ten pages) from prominent legal scholars and practitioners pertaining to any legal issue of importance.

The inaugural “Ideas” included essays from Dan Farber, Jonathan Macey, Ron Rotunda, and Aaron Twerski.

Since publication, “Ideas” has generated a great deal of attention. The Section has stimulated discussion on a number of blogs:

- **Conglomerate** ([commending “Ideas”](#) for providing an academic forum in which scholarly commentary on contemporary issues can be published in merely a matter of months)
- **Prawfsblawg** ([noting that the first collection of Ideas is “impressive” and commending the Law Review](#) for its savvy in making the section available online)

- **Ideoblog** ([discussing Macey’s piece on Disney](#) and generating the very kind of dialogue the “Ideas” were intended to stimulate)
