Range of Award:

Amount varies based on selected recipients.

The awarded amount will be applied toward the tuition cost of the E. David Woycik, Jr. Intensive Trial Techniques Program.

Eligibility:

All applicants must:

- must be a 2L or 3L student in good standing.
- have financial need; a completed 2025-2026 FAFSA must be on file.
- must demonstrate a commitment to pursuing a career in civil and/or criminal litigation and/or demonstrated excellence in trial and moot court competitions.

To apply for these scholarships, please submit:

- 1. A completed and signed scholarship application.
- 2. A copy of your resume.
- 3. A personal statement for each scholarship (please see application form for details).

All documents must be submitted as <u>one PDF file</u>, via email to lawfinaid@hofstra.edu, **no later than 5:00pm on Monday, November 17, 2025.**
